Who Can Receive a Screening Mammogram on Bonnie's Bus?

- Only **screening mammograms** are performed on Bonnie's Bus.
- Any woman age 40 or older can receive a screening mammogram on Bonnie's Bus.
- No one will be turned away due to inability to pay or lack of insurance.
- If a woman had a previous problem but has been returned to her routine mammogram schedule, she can receive a mammogram on Bonnie's Bus.

Age Requirements

- **Women 40 or older**
 - Any woman 40 or older can receive a screening mammogram on Bonnie's Bus.
- **Women 35-39**
 - Current American Cancer Society guidelines recommend annual screening mammograms for women 40 and above. If a woman 35-39 requests a baseline mammogram she must have a payment source.

Types of Payment Accepted

- Private Insurance
- Medicare
- Medicaid
- West Virginia Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program (WV BCCSP)
 - High risk women 40-49 who are enrolled in the program.
 - Any woman 50-64 who is enrolled in the program.
- Local Komen funds
 - Use of local Komen funds is determined by the grant recipient.
- Bonnie's Bus grant funds
 - Available for women 40 or older who are not covered by any of the payment options listed above.
